- If a book is damaged, we replace it at no cost.

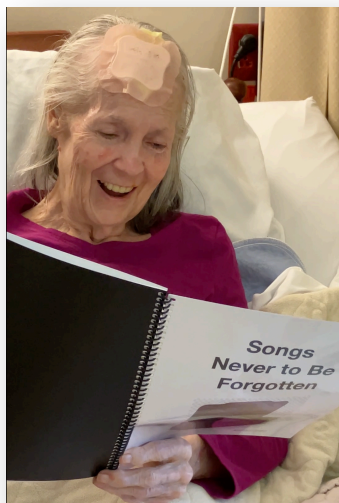


2. Lifetime Access to the Reading2Connect® Volunteer Training

The Reading2Connect® Training. Online, recorded, 30-minute video in which we explore:

- How dementia affects--and *does not* affect--one's ability to read.
- Putting the patient at ease, following their lead.
- Maximizing the patient's independence when interacting with the book

After volunteer trainees view the video, they participate in a live Q&A with Reading2Connect.
