- Enrich visits (remote and in-person) from families and friends.
- Design volunteer, student, and intergenerational programs.
- Enhance media and multi-sensory experiences.
- Offer compassionate responses to individuals feeling distressed.
- Foster diversity and inclusion in their community.
- Integrate reading into the daily lives of elders beyond programming.

In our training course, we implement a train-the-trainer approach. Trainees acquire sustainable, Montessori-based skills, highly applicable in all care and social situations with older adults. Reading2Connect-certified employees report decreased stress and increased job satisfaction. Residents living with dementia demonstrate increased social engagement and decreased negative emotions, during and after Reading2Connect® activities.
